The Peer Mentor will participate in the Native Connections community assessment, ongoing planning and intervention strategies for suicide awareness and preventative efforts. The Peer Mentor will engage with peers by providing peer support and linking to appropriate community services at FAIHP or other agencies/organizations. The Peer Mentor will provide ongoing collaboration with community members through outreach, media campaigns, linkage to resources, and education to reduce the stigma of mental health. This person should be very familiar and active within the American Indian/Alaska Native Community.
