### Summary

The Lead Navigator is responsible for conducting health education services for American Indian individuals receiving services from FAIHP. Health education may take place at FAIHP, associated clinics, or outreach sites including client's homes. The Lead Navigator is responsible for case management of clients in accordance with Standards of Care. The Lead Navigator will provide trainings and education around the risks of substance misuse, provide education on HIV/AIDS, and provide needed linkages to service provision for individuals with HIV; primarily serving those ages 13 through 24 years old. The Lead Navigator is part of a multi-disciplinary team working to establish services that enhance the health and well-being of the clients while developing their self-monitoring and/or healthier behaviors
